## **MOUNTAIN EXPRESS SERVICE UPDATE – AS OF DECEMBER 16, 2022**

The routes for Columbine and Snodgrass have changed on Fridays from 30-minute service to 60-minute service. Snodgrass and Columbine routes remain at 30-minute service on Saturdays and Sundays through the end of the Winter ski season.

As the winter ski season continues, Mountain Express may add additional routes and adjust its frequencies to better serve its patrons. Please go to [www.mtnexp.org](http://www.mtnexp.org) or find us on Google Maps for detailed route and schedule information.

New this year – Mountain Express will be removing ski racks from the outside of all buses due to prior difficulties with their use experienced by our patrons. When you bring your skis and snowboards inside the bus, please hold onto them during your ride, to avoid any inconvenience to your fellow passengers. If you can, please help your fellow passengers/neighbors with skis.
